To go along with the Porsche pictures on the computer desktop and screensaver, get your Porscheophile a "racey" mouse.



Motormouse.us.com sells 2.4G wireless mouse in the shape of a familiar sportcar! It is a fully functioning, highly engineered classic sport car design and a wireless digital computer mouse. It includes two buttons, a 12mm "spare tire" scroll wheel, The real tires are chrome alloy wheels. There are realistic headlights that blink when you click. The rear lights also lite up as you mouse. The opening trunk stores the bat-



teries and receiver. It comes boxed as a gift box, with a slick mouse pad and soft carry pouch. You can have one in metallic black, silver or red.

It is a little too small and ergonomically incorrect for someone who works at a computer all day. But for home use, it is a fun addition to any desktop.

To go along with that new mouse, a USB 4GB Porsche key drive is essential. In the shape of a Porsche key, it easily can fit on your key chain. It plugs and plays with PC's and Mac's.

Fold-out stick in the same design as the Porsche sports car vehicle key. Porsche Crest on the front. LED control light on the rear. The plug direction depends on the USB port being used. It can store up to 4 GB of data and is compatible with various operating systems including the Porsche Communication Management system with the individual Universal Audio Interface option. In Black with chrome. Dimensions: 53.5 x 38 x 19.5 mm

Ok so you have a Porscheophile who really won't be satisfied with anything this holiday season, that isn't another Porsche. She or he has a Boxster, 911, Cayenne. The need for another machine is strong. Luckily Porsche has given us two more models to choose from.



For those who also drive a car pool, the new Porsche Panamera is for you. Luxury, Comfort, Accommodations for four and the power of a Porsche, all in one package. It's the Porsche you drive for the rest of the week.

Your current Porsche may be your Sunday driver, but once you set yourself in the new Boxster Spyder, you will finally have one for Saturday.

The 320 horsepower delivers a ratio of 3.95 kg/hp. It is 80 kg lighter than the Boxster S Roadster, upon which it is based. Twenty-one kg were lost by getting rid of the automatic folding soft-top. Now you have to manually go topless, which is now held in place with clips and snaps. The engine cover and rear luggage compartment lid are replaced by a one-piece aluminum lid with twin convex fairings behind the roll hoops.

Other weight saving items: aluminum door skins, no door handles, lighter non-power seats, new alloy wheels, smaller fuel tank and battery and no radio or air conditioning.

Yep! No radio or air conditioning.

Oh and no cup holders either.

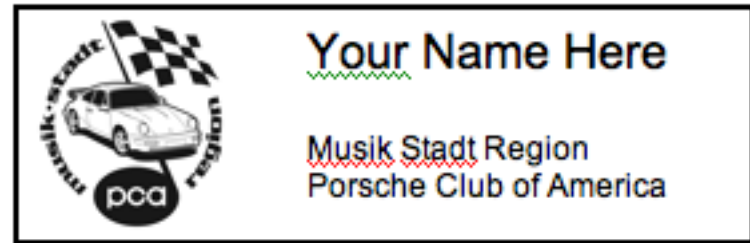
